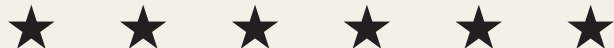

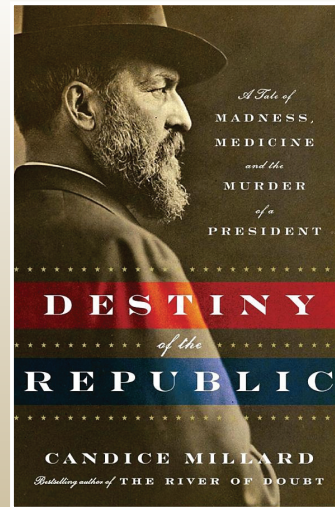

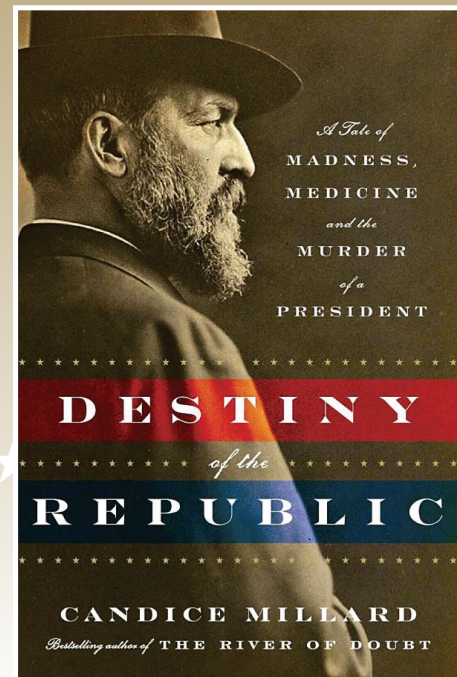

About *Destiny of the Republic*

“*Destiny of the Republic*” recounts the tale of James A. Garfield, one of America’s shortest serving presidents. Born into abject poverty, he rose to become a scholar, a Civil War hero, and a renowned and admired reformist congressman. Nominated for president against his will, he engaged in a fierce battle with the corrupt political establishment until a deranged office seeker shot him in the back.

It wasn’t the shot that killed Garfield. The drama of what happened subsequently is a powerful story of a nation in turmoil. The unhinged assassin’s half-delivered strike shattered the fragile national mood of a country so recently fractured by civil war, and left the wounded president as the object of a bitter behind-the-scenes struggle for power—over his administration, over the nation’s future, and, hauntingly, over his medical care. A team of physicians administered shockingly archaic treatments, to disastrous effect.

Candice Millard is a former writer and editor for *National Geographic*. The Kansas City resident is the author of the critically acclaimed and New York Times bestselling book “*The River of Doubt: Theodore Roosevelt’s Darkest Journey*.” It was named one of the best books of the year by, among others, The New York Times, The Washington Post, The San Francisco Chronicle, and The Christian Science Monitor. *The River of Doubt* was a Barnes & Noble Discover Great New Writers selection and a Book Sense Pick, was a finalist for the Quill Awards, and won the William Rockhill Nelson Award. Millard’s work has also appeared in *Time* magazine, The Washington Post Book World, and The New York Times Book Review.
